

NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

This Mutual Non-Disclosure Agreement (this "Agreement") is made, between visitors of OlumuyiwaOlumide.com - Ruling Of Africa (Consolidate Debt) Kewibra.com - OM YogiPad Kewishop.com - Beauty + Science (Apparel) CouplesBnb.org - Couples Bed and Breakfast FolioDesignGroup.com - Web Engineering BoomBoomEmpire.com - Production Studio FolioSampleDesign.com - Technology Development BoomBoomMansion.com - Online Dating BoomBoomTV.org - Television LasGidigoons.com - Blockbuster Film, Coming Fall 2020 BoomBoomMansionRecords.com - Record Company ThePoetryGroup.org - Owning Poetry As A Category Online Inc (together, the "Company") and Muiyiwa Olumide, on behalf of himself, Kewi and Kiwii Lingerie (together, "Kewi").

Company and Kewi desire to begin discussions regarding a business opportunity of mutual interest (the "Business Purpose"), which Business Purpose includes a possible sale of IP and/or the licensing or co-licensing of certain intellectual property developed by Kewi. In connection with such discussions, Company and Kewi recognize that there is a need to disclose to each other certain confidential information of each party to be used only for the Business Purpose and to protect such confidential information from unauthorized use and disclosure.

In consideration of the other party's disclosure of such confidential information, each party agrees as follows:

1. For purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" means any technical or business information disclosed by one party to the other party that: (i) if disclosed in writing, is marked "confidential" or "proprietary" at the time of such disclosure; (ii) if disclosed orally, is identified as "confidential" or "proprietary" at the time of such disclosure, and is summarized in a writing sent by the disclosing party to the receiving party within thirty (30) days after any such disclosure; or (iii) under the circumstances, a person exercising reasonable business judgment would understand to be confidential or proprietary.

2. Each party agrees: (i) to maintain the other party's Confidential Information in strict confidence; (ii) not to disclose such Confidential Information to any third parties; (iii) not to copy or otherwise reproduce Confidential Information in whole or in part, nor make improvements upon it; and (iv) not to use any such Confidential Information for any purpose except for the Business Purpose. Each party may disclose the Confidential Information of the other party solely to its employees and consultants who have a bona fide need to know such Confidential Information for the Business Purpose, but solely to the extent necessary to pursue the Business Purpose, and for no other purpose; provided that each such employee and consultant first executes a written agreement (or is otherwise already bound by a written agreement) that contains use and nondisclosure restrictions at least as protective of the other party's Confidential Information as those set forth in this Agreement. The provisions of this Section 2 will not restrict a party from disclosing the other party's Confidential Information to the extent required by any law or regulation; provided that the party required to make such a disclosure uses its reasonable efforts to give the other party reasonable advance notice of such required disclosure in order to enable the other party to prevent or limit such disclosure.

3. Confidential Information will not include information that: (i) is now or hereafter becomes generally known or available to the public, through no act or omission on the part of the receiving party; (ii) was known by the receiving party prior to receiving such information from the disclosing

party and without restriction as to use or disclosure; (iii) is rightfully acquired by the receiving party from a third party who has the right to disclose it and who provides it without restriction as to use or disclosure; or (iv) is independently developed by the receiving party without access to any Confidential Information, as evidenced by receiving party's written records.

4. Upon the disclosing party's request, the receiving party will promptly return to the disclosing party all tangible items and embodiments containing or consisting of the disclosing party's Confidential Information and all copies thereof (including electronic copies).

5. All Confidential Information remains the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing party. Each party acknowledges and agrees that nothing in this Agreement will be construed as granting any rights to the receiving party, by license or otherwise, in or to any Confidential Information of the disclosing party, or any patent, copyright or other intellectual property or proprietary rights of the disclosing party, except as specified in this Agreement.

6. ALL CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION IS PROVIDED BY THE DISCLOSING PARTY "AS IS."

7. Each party acknowledges that the unauthorized use, modification or disclosure of the disclosing party's Confidential Information would cause the disclosing party to incur irreparable harm and significant damages, the degree of which may be difficult to ascertain. Accordingly, each party agrees that the disclosing party will have the right to obtain immediate equitable relief to enjoin any unauthorized use or disclosure of its Confidential Information, in addition to any other rights and remedies that it may have at law or otherwise.

8. This Agreement will be construed, interpreted, and applied in accordance with the laws of the State of California (excluding its body of law controlling conflicts of law). This Agreement is the complete and exclusive statement regarding the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings and communications, oral or written, between the parties regarding the subject matter of this Agreement. Neither party may assign this Agreement, in whole or in part, without the other party's prior written consent, and any attempted assignment without such consent will be void.

9. This Agreement will commence on the date first set forth above and will remain in effect for five (5) years from the date of the last disclosure of Confidential Information by either party, at which time it will terminate.
